- Synchronized Evidence & Event Logging

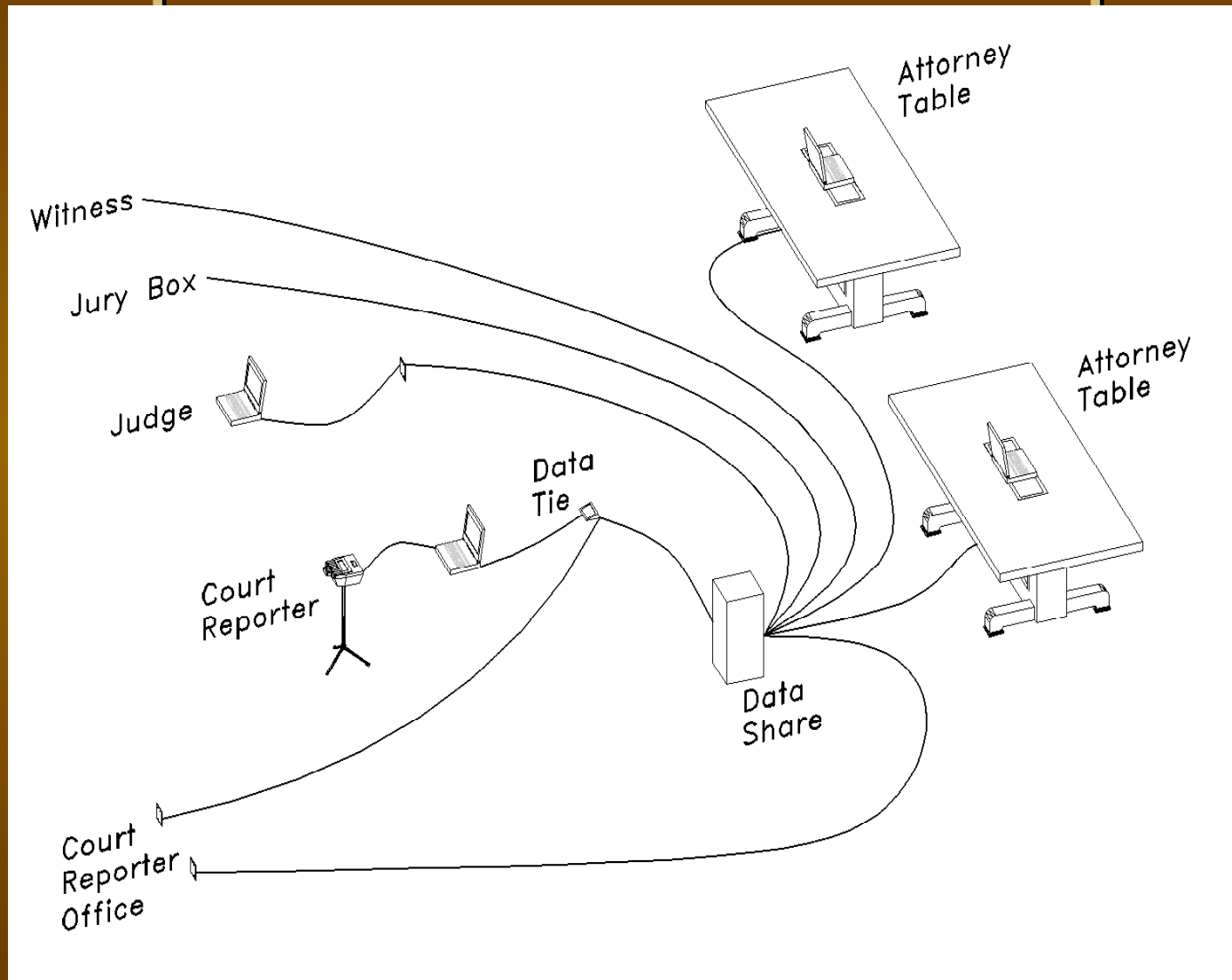


Computer Aided Transcription

- Sustainable via Software



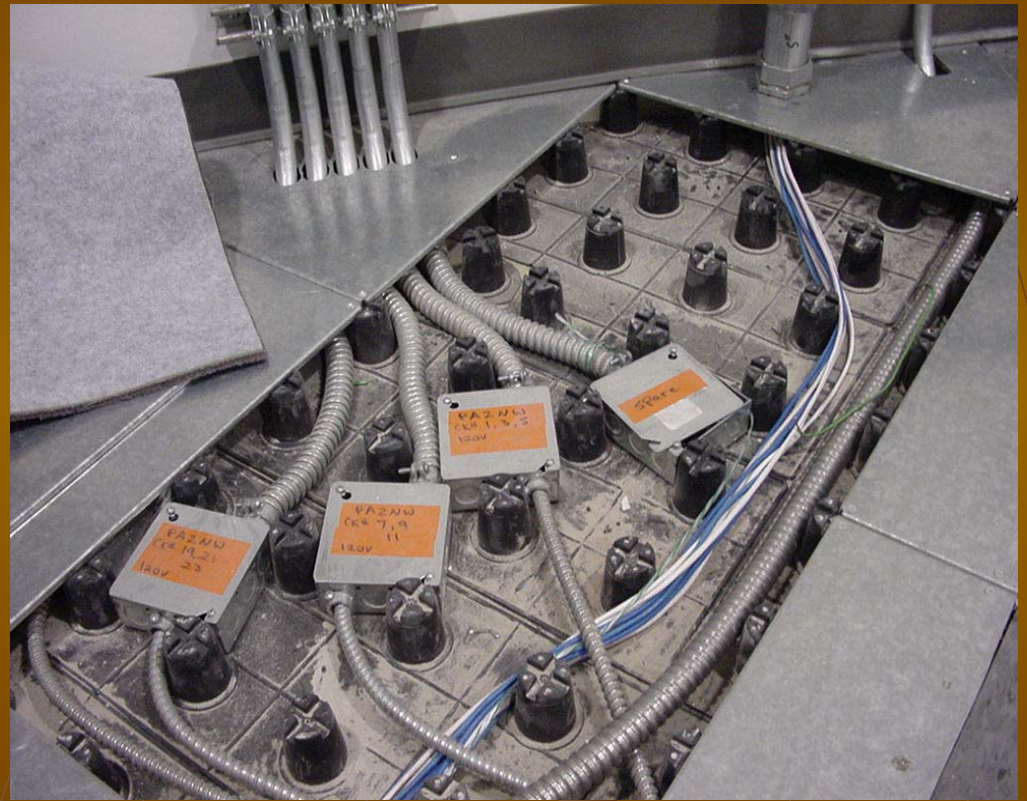
Security Monitoring & Duress
